From the Community Lay Director –Jim Deal

In Matthew 7:15-20 Jesus teaches the disciples how to tell a true Christian from a false one. He warns about people who appear to be sheep on the outside, but are really wolves on the inside. To make the correct judgments, Jesus uses fruit trees as an example. He points out that good trees bear good fruit while bad trees bear bad fruit. Rather than relying on appearances, Jesus instructs us to be fruit inspectors. Two times Jesus says, "By their fruit you will recognize them." So, where's the fruit?

Galatians 5:22-23 lists the fruits of living a Spirit-led life. A true Christian will be bearing the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. In Emmaus, we sing "They will know we are Christians by our love." They will also know we are Christians because we have joy, because they see our patience, because we are good and so on.

You have opportunities to show your fruit in the Emmaus community. Using kindness and gentleness, seek to sponsor someone on a walk. It may require patience! Spread joy by making agape for the walks. Be faithful in attendance at all Emmaus events, including Gatherings and Candlelights. Experience God's peace by joining a reunion group. By being a good tree bearing good fruit, everyone will know you love the Lord. So, let us see your fruit!
